IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE MATTER
REGARDING CASE ASSIGNMENTS FOR ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #24-05
CRIMINAL OFFENSES COMMITTED
WITHIN THE RESORT CORRIDOR

WHEREAS, Administrative Order #23-04 established procedures for the designation of two "Resort Corridor Courts" which were assigned a docket of all criminal cases where the alleged offense was committed within a defined "Resort Corridor"; and

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2024, the Las Vegas Justice Court informed the Court's justice partners that the two designated Resort Corridor Court courtrooms will "sunset" by a specified date; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that if a criminal case involves one or more criminal offenses occurring in the Resort Corridor, and if that criminal case is filed on or after November 1, 2024, that criminal case will be randomly assigned to one of the Criminal departments of the Las Vegas Justice Court, unless assignment to a designated-caseload department is implicated;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any cases previously assigned to a Resort Corridor Court department will remain in that assigned department, unless otherwise ordered by the judge of that assigned department; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, effective on November 1, 2024, this Administrative Order shall be deemed to rescind and replace Administrative Order #23-04.
