8 WHEREAS, JCRLV 6.5 allows the Chief Judge to make "such orders as deemed
9 advisable" relating to local court rules and procedure; and

WHEREAS, effective Tuesday, July 20, 2021, Clark County Management has reinitiated
mandatory mask requirements for all employees that work indoors in all Country facilities when
in common or public areas, including hallways, meeting rooms, break rooms, restrooms, etc.;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Administrative Order #21-05 is now rescinded; and IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective immediately, all Las Vegas Justice Court judges, employees, and vendors must cover their noses and mouths with face coverings while at work unless they are alone in unshared work space.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effectively immediately, all attorneys, vendors,
employees of any organization or entity, or any member of the public over the age of two years
old, entering Las Vegas Justice Court courtrooms, workspace, or area open to the public must
wear face coverings at all times while in any Justice Court courtroom or workspace.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that individuals who are unable to wear a face covering
for a Court proceeding should make arrangements to appear by alternative means; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order will remain in effect until modified or
rescinded by a subsequent order.
