#### Biography/ Candidate's Statement

Tyler Ingram was born and raised in Fallon, Nevada. After graduating from the University of Nevada Reno, Tyler earned his Juris Doctor degree from Thomas M. Cooley law school in Lansing, Michigan, and then completed a one-year law clerk position for the Honorable Albert Northrop in Prince George's County, Maryland. Tyler was admitted to practice law in Nevada in 2010 and then moved back home to Nevada where he began his career as a prosecutor with the Elko County District Attorney's Office.

In 2016, the Elko County Board of Commissioners appointed Tyler as Elko County District Attorney and he was elected to that position in 2018 and again in 2022. Tyler served as the Nevada District Attorney's Association President and in 2021, the Nevada Attorney General appointed him to the statewide Committee on Domestic Violence. Tyler serves as the co-chair of the statewide Fatality Review Team and is a member of the Mule Deer Enhancement Subcommittee for the Nevada Department of Wildlife. Additionally, Tyler is the chair of the Community Development Committee for Nevada Gold Mines.

While serving as District Attorney, Tyler approached the Elko County Board of Commissioners with a request to build and operate rural Nevada's first accredited Child Advocacy Center, and in 2023 the Great Basin Children's Advocacy Center opened its doors to provide much-needed services to victims of child abuse for Elko, Eureka, Lander, and White Pine County.
