- **Challenge Period – February – May 31, 2023**
- **Competition** - sections are challenged to encourage section members to participate in the Pro Bono Challenge. Commit online to:
 - **Take a Case** with a legal aid provider **Earns 3 points**
 - **Volunteer for an Ask-A-Lawyer** **Earns 2 points**
 - **Donate in lieu of pro bono** **Every \$500 earns 1 point**
- **How to Participate**
 - Sign your section up
 - Assign a section member to serve as the main contact and to communicate challenge details to section members
 - Help to track your section's involvement (the bar and legal aid will help)
 - Brad Lewis of the Access to Justice Commission will be the staff contact supporting this effort and will guide and help section efforts with draft emails, questions, etc. bradl@nvbar.org
- **Goal targets** (4777 total section members)
 - 475 section members participate in some way
 - Taking a case through legal aid
 - Volunteering for an Ask-A-Lawyer
 - Donating in lieu of pro bono
- **Section recognition** (even playing field based on total points earned in relation section size)
 - Honored at State Bar annual conference June 2023, *Nevada Lawyer* & social media
 - Top volunteer from each of the Top 10 sections wins lunch with the Nevada Supreme Court and Nevada Court of Appeals
 - All participating section members invited to Eighth Judicial District Court and/or Second Judicial District Court judicial reception
 - Bragging rights for winning section
