

"I volunteer with the Southern Nevada Senior Law



"As a bilingual attorney, most of the clients I help (at SLP) are Spanish-speaking only. They are usually first-generation immigrants who lack an understanding of the laws and have the misconception that basic estate planning is only necessary for the rich. The lack of professionals to whom they can relate only compounds these cultural barriers. There are few Spanish-speaking attorneys and even fewer who are knowledgeable in estate planning matters.

"I believe everyone should give back, especially attorneys, and that we have a moral obligation to serve the community. Anyone can do community service, but only licensed professionals can provide this service.

"I find it rewarding to watch a client have an 'aha' moment. Someone told them they needed these documents, but they had no understanding of why or what they were. After explaining the purpose and necessity of the documents, the clients can make informed decisions and leave feeling empowered.

"It is extremely important to participate in pro bono to remind yourself of the purpose and beauty of the law, which is justice, and provide those with access to justice who would otherwise be denied.

"I think SLP is pretty amazing, and I am blessed to be a part of the SLP family."
