

STATE BAR OF NEVADA ELECTIONS 2023 Nominating Petition

The Board of Governors of the State Bar consists of 15 members elected by the active members of the Bar who are residents of Nevada and have their official address per SCR 79 in the respective districts. There are fifteen members as follows:

- Nine from District One (Clark County)
- One from District Two (White Pine, Elko, Eureka, Churchill, Lander, Humboldt, Lyon, Lincoln, Douglas, Mineral, Nye, Esmeralda, Pershing and Storey Counties)
- One from District Three (Carson City)
- Four from District Four (Washoe County)

The terms of office are staggered with each elected for a term of three years.

For 2023, the following positions are open for election.

District One – Clark County Four seats

District Four – Washoe County Two seats

Nominations for the Board of Governors shall be by petition signed by at least five members entitled to vote for the nominee. A nominating petition form is available at www.nvbar.org or upon request to Manny Botello at mannyb@nvbar.org.

Petitions must be submitted to the State Bar office at 3100 W Charleston Blvd., Las Vegas, NV 89102 or by email to mannyb@nvbar.org, not earlier than March 15, 2023, nor later than April 1, 2023.
